- **Intentional Apprenticeship |** We believe that following Jesus involves implementing a strategy to enthrall yourself with God and eliminate any obstacles or responses that stand against God's good intentions for you. As a leader, I will align my faith journey with this as I continue to grow in my own faith and lead others to do the same.
- **Authentic Community | Me too | Pursuing truth together is the best opportunity for truly living out and applying that truth.** I will lead out with a "me too" attitude, rather than out of authority or position, and engage in and encourage others to enter into community that seeks Jesus in all aspects of grief and healing.
- **Gifted Service | Purpose and personality | We recognize that God distributes spiritual gifts (time, talents, treasure) to equip the church in order to serve as Christ to the world.** As a leader, I am willing to adjust my time, my abilities and my resources to align with the giftedness and direction with which God has trusted me.
- **Excellent environments | Bump into Jesus | We aren't in the business of changing people. Rather, we embrace our role as creating a space where people can work out their stuff with Jesus.** I understand that it is not my job to change, fix or save anyone. As a leader, it is my responsibility to provide and protect an environment that allows others to hear from God and process what God may be teaching them.
