Discussion Questions WEEK 2

In his talk, Stefan broke down “stewardship” into three parts that goes like this – each of us has been given a certain amount of **time**, **talents**, and **treasures** in our lives. That’s just true, whether you’re a follow of Jesus or not. Stewardship is a shift away from us using those things for our own benefit, and appropriating them for the greater good of the Church. But not because WE have to, but because we want to.

As Christians, let’s take put these areas of our life under the microscope and reevaluate our choices.

1. **Read The Parable of the Talents: Matthew 25:14-30**
2. **Time:** According to this passage, what do you think God values how you spend your time? Look at what you journaled, what do you need to change in how you’re spending your time to re-align yourself with what God values?
3. **Talents:** After reading that passage, how are you using your gifting’s? If you are not using your gifts, why not? (It’s okay if you don’t know, pray about it this week)
4. **Treasure:** Look at your journal, what area are you spending the most money on, do you think that needs to change? According to the passage, what does God say is most important about how you use your money?
