4. Dallas Willard said, "We are at the mercy of our ideas, not our beliefs." What are some things that have shaped how you think, believe, and see the world? How have those factors influenced what you believe about God?
5. **Read 1 John 4:9-10.** What ideas do you have about God and Jesus that may not be true in light of this scripture? How can you let **1 John 4:9-10** shape your ideas about God?
6. How do you think you can take part of what God is doing around the world and in your own neighborhood? Where can you be a light in a dark place?
7. Jim said, "Being saved is about more than having your sins forgiven and going to heaven rather than going to hell when you die." Do you struggle with the truth that the salvation Jesus offers affects your life in the here and now and that Jesus wants something better for your current life?

Read **John 10:10**. Take some time this week to write down some things that the thief has stolen, killed, and destroyed in your life. Then write down what you think Jesus means by offering you an abundant life, and what you can do today to remember that truth.
